TSA Travel Trips

Lake Ouachita outing Labor Day

Hello Diving Rebels,

I have been asked to put together an article for the Lake Ouachita trip as our August outing, August 29 – Sep 1, 2003. I have volunteered to be the coordinator and as such will be looking for lieutenant coordinators. To cover the cost remaining cost of the boat, gas and food, a \$50 deposit per person will be required (can be paid up to 1 week after the Aug 6th meeting and will be refunded up to 1 week prior to the trip upon cancellation – Aug 22nd is refund date). If we come in under budget, the remains will be returned pro rata share. I am committing to be responsible for two meals, Saturday dinner and Sunday breakfast. George has taken Saturday breakfast and Scott, Monday breakfast. Oggie will handle Sunday lunch. We need Lt. coordinators for lunch Sat and dinner Sun night. All meal Lt. coordinators need to submit receipts to me for reimbursement. Friday dinner and Monday lunch are up to the individual member. Okay enough with the most important – food and on to the fun.

I am picking up the dive barge at 3pm on Friday and it takes a while to drive it around Lake Ouachita to Brady Mountain Marina, which is the pick up/drop off point. [Directions below] The first pick up will be approximately 5pm and departing for the island at 6:00. An evening/night dive will be available and the next pickup will be 11pm departing for the island at 11:30. The pick up on Saturday will be at 1pm departing at 2:00. Depending on how many and the cargo involved, this may be on the way to a dive, or back to the island to unload gear. The next pick up will be 2pm leaving at 2:30 for a trip to the island. Afternoon dives begin at 3 and will finish about 6. If there are any stragglers we can make a pick up on the way back. Saturday night dives will be at the cove or island. Sunday diving begins at 9:30am until about noon and afternoon dives begin about 2:30 – 5. Night dives will begin after dinner at approximately 9pm. Monday will consist of a first trip at 9am to the drop off, diving until noon and a last drop off at 1pm and delivering the boat back to the rental marina by 3pm. I'll convert this narrative to a schedule format later so don't worry too much. I tried to allow good surface intervals because some of these dive profiles can be 80 to 100 feet.

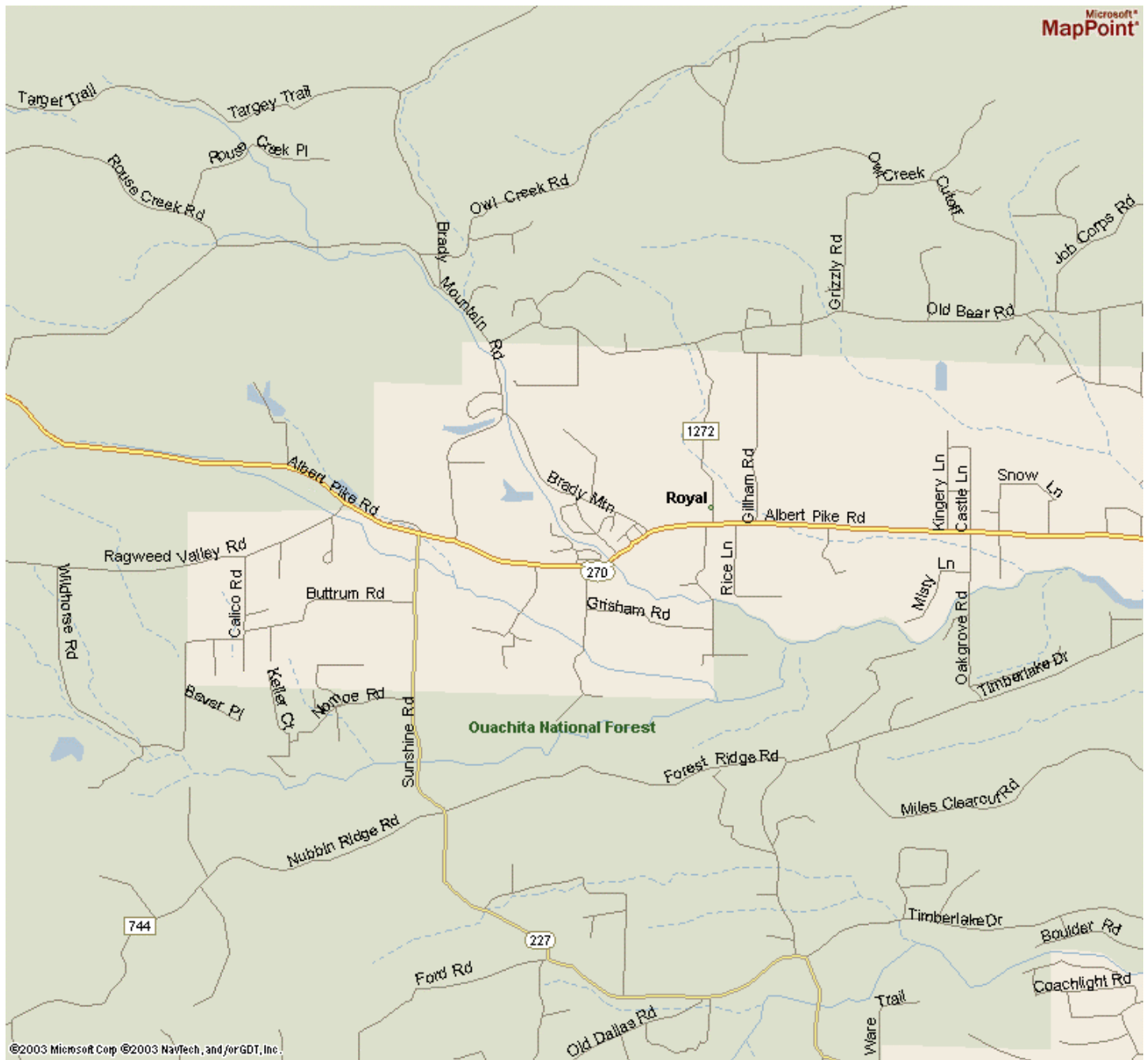
To get to Brady Mountain Marina Take I-30 to HWY 70 to Hot Springs. Out of Hot Springs take 270 west until you see the sign on the right and turn there (Brady Mountain Rd). This should be about ½ mile past FM1272 and Royal, AR. Their phone number is 501-767-3422.
